



Franchise Brokers Association Event Solicitation Policy

Franchise Brokers Association (“FBA”) has a no-solicitation policy covering all of our Conferences and Expositions, both in-person and virtual. To provide a distraction-free environment for our exhibitors, sponsors, attendees, and employees, we do not allow solicitation at our events by attendees or unauthorized parties without the express prior written consent and permission of FBA.

This policy includes, but is not limited to, the following unauthorized solicitation activities:

- Virtual video chats
- Virtual text chats
- Receptions and parties (virtual and in-person)
- Expos, booths, and suites (virtual and in-person)
- Membership recruitment
- Employment recruitment
- Promotion of non-FBA events
- On-site distribution of printed or electronic materials (virtual and in-person)

Any person or organization found to be violating this policy, or anyone found to be sharing admission tickets or virtual event login information, may be expelled from the event. No refunds will be provided. Egregious or multiple violations of this policy may result in disqualification from future events or loss of membership, at the sole discretion of FBA.
